## SAFETY FOR HOST FAMILIES, HOST STUDENTS, AND EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Code of Conduct for Host Families and Host Students:

**Host Student Commitment:** 

- 1. If I have the opportunity to host an exchange student, I commit to doing everything I can to ensure its success: I will be attentive to the exchange student and strive to accommodate their habits. I will ensure good relations with my exchange partner and will show myself to be helpful.
- 2. In class, I will be a good role model when they shadow me at Saint Francis and will respect the rules of the school. I will be an excellent ambassador for my family and for Saint Francis High School, helping to foster future exchanges. My behavior and appearance will be exemplary. I will respect the school's internal regulations (available on the school's website), which also apply during school trips and exchanges.

- 3. In the United States, students are under the responsibility of the school during class and bus transport, and under the responsibility of their host family at all other times. I will not take my exchange student out without their permission.
- 4. The consumption of alcohol (for all minors in the United States) or any harmful or toxic substances is strictly prohibited for the entire duration of the stay.

## French Exchange Student Agreements

- 1. All French students participating in the exchange have made a firm, written commitment to respectful, safe, and culturally sensitive behavior.
- 2. Students pledge to be attentive, adaptable, and courteous toward their host families, participate fully and respectfully in school life, and maintain exemplary conduct as ambassadors of their home institution.
- 3. They are not allowed to leave the home without host family permission and are strictly forbidden from using alcohol or other substances.
- 4. Tobacco use for some French exchange students is only permitted in very limited circumstances and only with prior written parental consent.
- 5. Violations of these rules can result in serious disciplinary consequences, including the potential for dismissal from their school in France.

Thank you for applying to be a host family for Saint Francis High School. It is best practice to have you cleared as a volunteer for the reassurance of the safety of our community. In order to do so, we will ask that each adult living in the household completes: 1) Live Scan Fingerprinting, 2) TB Clearance, and 3) Safe Environment training.
